- 4. Filing of an application for acceptance as a psychology major which shall include an autobiographical essay. (See instruction below). The application can be filed any time following the completion of the student's third semester of college work.

The applicant will be evaluated for admission as a psychology major when the following materials are submitted to the psychology office:

- 1. Departmental application including essay
- 2. \$20.00 application fee (non-refundable)
- 3. Grade report from BSI account (cum. gpa)
- 4. Applicant may be required to interview with chair/faculty
